TEACHER APPLICATION FORM

Please find attached the Teaching Application Form for Chinook Learning's non-credit Summer School programs. We are looking for teachers who are passionate about teaching students, are knowledgeable about current curriculum outcomes, are creative and have experience teaching through the Inquiry-Based learning approach.

Remedial Summer School (Grades 1-9): 8:00am – 10:00am or 10:15am – 12:15pm

This is a three-week (30 hour) program for students who would benefit from a review of the key curriculum outcomes in the grade they have just completed. Teachers are expected to prepare their own materials based on the Alberta Learning Program of Studies. The Remedial Program is intended to help students build confidence, provide opportunities for success, and reinforce the skills learned throughout the past year of schooling.

ELL (Grades 1-9): 8:00am – 12:15pm daily

This is a three week, half-day program (60 hours) for students new to Canada. The content focuses on furthering the development of literacy skills and conversation skills. The program is designed to foster English language growth and development in the areas of speaking, listening, reading and writing. This will be accomplished through providing structured teaching and a variety of fun activities (i.e. Cooking, crafts, drama, play and outdoor activities etc.). Students will be grouped by ability on the first day.

Study Skills (Grades 7-9): 10:00am – 12:15pm daily

This is a three week course that is designed to assist students in developing study skills through providing strategies that will assist them in developing goal setting routines, time management and organizational skills, and homework planning strategies. Teachers will also teach students tips and tricks that will help them prepare for tests and exams in more effective ways. Teachers are expected to prepare their own materials.

The Summer School Principal from each site will make employment selections. Positions are tentative until after the student registration deadline of July 4, 2012.

Teachers will be paid the current ATA rate of \$64.75/ hr. Regular deductions will apply. Please complete the entire application and forward it to Angie Schulz by April 13, 2012. You will receive an email confirming that the application was received. Eligible applicants will be contacted for an interview. Teachers will be offered contracts for positions, depending on the number registrants for each program.
